REASON FOR EXCURSION: School camps provide opportunities to build community and practical learning activities. They develop students' resilience and skills in leadership, problem solving, teamwork and positive life choices. As part of Dawson Park Primary Schools continued effort to grow and develop our Year 6's into mature and young adults we have organised an opportunity for the Year 6's to attend a three day camp.

ACTIVITIES TO BE CONDUCTED: Abseil Tower, Big Fox, Climbing Wall, Crate Climb, Pamper Pole, Target Shooting, Kayak – Flat Water, Ski Biscuiting.

DATES & TIMES: Monday November 13, 2023 at 8:15am to Wednesday November 15, 2023 at 3:00pm.

COST: The total cost for this three day camp is \$433.00 per student. These costs include all accommodation, all food and all activities at the Forest Edge Recreation Camp. It also includes the bus to travel to and from the camp ground in Waroona. With support from the Dawson Park Primary School P&C, our school community is collecting cans and bottles to fundraise to subsidise some of the costs of camp. Any money that is overpaid due to this initiative will be organised as a credit towards your child's graduation at the end of the year.

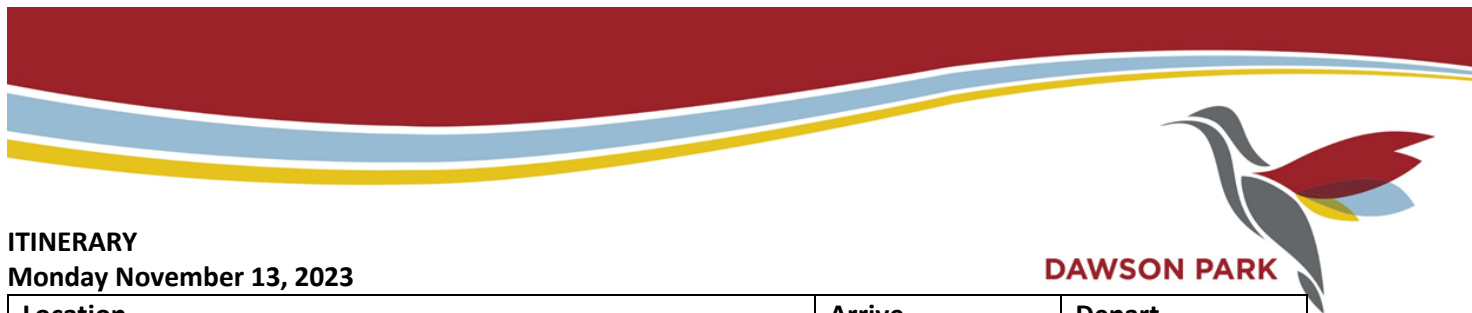

STUDENT CONTACT ARRANGEMENTS DURING EXCURSION: Student records will be retained throughout the excursion including the two emergency contact details for each student. In addition to the bus service a vehicle will be available at all times in the case of emergency first aid or student removal from camp.

SUPERVISION TO BE PROVIDED: Stephen Cummings (Provide First Aid), Luke Colace (Provide First Aid), Enoch Yap (Provide First Aid), Zachary Rumsey, Danielle Cordony and another staff members will attend.

STAFF ACTION IN CASE OF ACCIDENT OR ILLNESS ON THE EXCURSION: From records, students parent/carer will be contacted. If neither of the listed emergency contacts are unable to be contacted at the time of the incident. A member of the administration team from Dawson Park Primary School will be contacted.

SPECIAL CLOTHING OR OTHER ITEMS REQUIRED: On this camp, the students will each be participating in eight activities. These activities are an abseil tower, big fox, climbing wall, crate climb, pamper pole, target shooting, kayak – flat water, ski biscuiting. As two of these activities are a water based activity, it is important that students pack accordingly. Please see the attached checklist for a comprehensive list of things to pack and avoid for the three day camp.

Students are not permitted to bring any mobile phones, cameras, money or lollies on camp. If any of these items are found on camp, they will be confiscated immediately and appropriately deemed consequences will be put in place immediately. Staff will take photos on the camp and will distribute electronically at a date after returning. Student will be given some lollies at staff's discretion.

What to bring



General

- Underwear (including spares)
- Long socks
- Suitable clothing for the number of days at Forest Edge (we highly recommended not bringing any new clothing)
- At least 2 warm jumpers (all year round)
- 1 waterproof jacket or raincoat (all year round)
- Long pants for bushwalking
- 2 pairs of old shoes for general use
- 1 pair of shoes/booties/reef shoes suitable for wearing during water activities (thongs are not suitable – footwear must be secure)
- Beanie (optional)
- Bathers, rashie and beach towel (for any water activities)
- Personal toiletries and bath towel
- Backpack
- Torch

NO singlets, skirts or short shorts.

NO spray deodorant only roll on.

For all activities:

- Sun-smart/wet weather clothing
- Hat (bucket hat preferred)
- Sunscreen
- Drink bottle

Bedding:

- Each bed has a mattress and clean bottom sheet only. In order to maintain the highest standard of hygiene while on camp, it is necessary to bring your own pillow and pillow case.
- Sleeping bag
