REASON FOR EXCURSION: Swimming lessons are provided by the Department of Education and form an integral part of the Health and Physical Education Program. Due to the health and safety benefits of being able to swim all students are expected to attend. Although these lessons are provided free, the cost of transport (bus fare non-refundable) and admission charges to the pool need to be met by parents. This works out to only **\$5.50** per day for your child to not only save their own life but maybe someone else's.

NOTE:
