

Year 6 3 Day Camp

To be retained by parent/caregiver

As part of Dawson Park Primary School's ongoing commitment to supporting the growth and development of our Year 6 students, we are pleased to offer them the opportunity to attend a three-day school camp. We believe this camp will be a valuable step in forming strong friendship bonds and guiding our Year 6 students as they mature into confident and capable young adults.

ACTIVITIES TO BE CONDUCTED: Rock Climbing, Archery, Team Building Activities, Orienteering, Flying Fox, Abseiling, Search and Rescue, Catapult Constructing and Escape from Quarantine.

DATES & TIMES: Monday June 23, 2025 at 10:00am to Wednesday June 25, 2025 at 3:00pm.

COST: The total cost for this three-day camp is **\$220.00 per student**. These costs include lunch on the first day, all accommodation, all food and all activities at the Woodman Point Recreation Camp. It also includes the bus to travel to and from the campground in Coogee.

The school camp has relocated and is now offered at a discounted rate. This adjustment is part of the Cook Labor Government's \$2.4 million initiative aimed at providing cost-of-living relief for Western Australian families by assisting with public school camp expenses. While the duration of this initiative is currently uncertain, we hope it will continue to support future camps.

Credit Card is preferred payment method. Cash is also acceptable, please be aware that the correct amount must be enclosed as no change can be given.

Consent forms are due back to the office by Tuesday 3 June 2025 to confirm numbers. If consent forms are not returned by this date your child will not be able to attend.

Full payment is due to the office by Monday 16 June 2025.



LOCATION: Woodman Point Recreation Camp (74 O'Kane Ct, Coogee WA 6166)

TRANSPORT AND TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS: Students will travel to and from Woodman Point Recreation Camp (74 O'Kane Ct, Coogee WA 6166) via bus service provided by Kinetic WA.

If you require alternative arrangements for your child's pick up from Dawson Park Primary School on Wednesday June 25, 2025, please inform Enoch Yap in writing prior to the consent form due date.

STUDENT CONTACT ARRANGEMENTS DURING EXCURSION: Student records will be retained throughout the excursion including the two emergency contact details for each student. In addition to the bus service a vehicle will be available at all times in the case of emergency first aid or student removal from camp.







STAFF ACTION IN CASE OF ACCIDENT OR ILLNESS ON THE EXCURSION: From records, students parent/carer will be contacted. If neither of the listed emergency contacts are unable to be contacted at the time of the incident. A member of the administration team from Dawson Park Primary School will be contacted.

SPECIAL CLOTHING OR OTHER ITEMS REQUIRED:

Students are not permitted to bring any mobile phones, cameras, money or lollies on camp. If any of these items are found on camp, they will be confiscated immediately and appropriately deemed consequences will be put in place immediately. Staff will take photos on the camp and will distribute electronically at a date after returning. Student will be given some lollies at staff's discretion.

NOTE:

Staff accompanying students on excursions will take all reasonable care while the students are in their charge to protect them from injury and to control and supervise their behaviour and activities. Parents/guardians should be aware that staff members are not responsible for injuries or damage to property which may occur on an excursion where, in all circumstances, staff have not been negligent.

In the case of excursions not involving an overnight stay, costs incurred as a result of accident or illness are the responsibilities of the parent/guardian. The school camp/excursions insurance policy applies for approved camps/excursions involving an overnight stay. The policy covers students to a maximum of \$10,000 for medical and ancillary expenses where Medicare or private health insurance does not cover these costs. Parents are required to inform the organisers well before the scheduled excursion departure of any change to their child's health and fitness so that appropriate supervision may be arranged. Where it is considered necessary, school staff will arrange medical assessment and treatment for students.
